## V. Public Hearings

Public Hearing on the Town's Fiscal Year 2018/2019 (FY19) Millage Rates and Annual Budget –Town Manager Daniels

Town Manager Daniels said there are 2 resolutions that need to be read by title. He said the FY19 millage rate is 4.3885 mils which is 10% higher than the rollback rate of 3.9897.

#### VI. New Business

A. Resolution 2018-04, Adopting the Tentative Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 – Town Manager Daniels

Mayor Simmons read Resolution 2018-04 by title:

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MELBOURNE BEACH OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Commissioner Walters made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-04 setting the tentative operating millage rate for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 at 4.3885 mills which is greater than the roll back rate of 3.9897 by 10.00% and setting the tentative debt service millage rate for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 at .9999%; Commissioner Quarrie seconded.

B. Resolution 2018-05, Adopting the Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 – Town Manager Daniels

Mayor Simmons read Resolution 2018-05 by title:

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MELBOURNE BEACH OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Katherine Wilborn 502 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue

Ms. Wilborn said she reviewed the budget the previous evening and she didn't see where any money was being on spent on repairs to the stormwater system at the intersection of 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and Pine. She has gone to the areas in Town where stormwater repairs are being made and she doesn't feel that those areas should have been addressed prior to 2<sup>nd</sup>/Pine. She has experienced flooding at her house and has asked for over a year that something be done about it; it's a public safety issue.

Commissioner Walters made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-05 setting forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 in the amount of \$3,073,460; Commissioner Quarrie seconded.
