



January 2017 Monthly Report:

During the month of January our officers once again were able to keep our crime activity low. Our officers use all tools available, from Community Policing, to aggressive pro-active tactics to prevent crime in our Town. The month of January we had zero business burglary, six vehicle burglaries (All vehicles left unlocked) also six individuals were identified and Warrants were sent to the State Attorney Office for prosecution. We had two residential (Arrest made on Residential burglaries). I also come in on nights and will continue to assist with being pro-active and reduce our crime. We conducted several traffic enforcement details throughout the Town, due to resident complaints, and issued 12 traffic citations.

Animal Complaints, we had 5 calls this month. The majority of our animal complaints consist of stray, loose or injured pets, dogs in the Park or on the beach. These complaints also include calls for poisonous snakes, raccoons, etc.

Areas with a high volume calls for service are Injured or ILL persons. These types of calls are unpredictable in nature. Our Officers are First Responders and are first on scene with a medical call and are certified to perform CPR and A.E.D.

I do not see any type of trend on any major crime in the Town. I can tell you that all calls for service and crime are looked at every day and analyzed by myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take appropriate action to resolve the issue. I assure the residents that our Town is protected 24/7 and we will use all resources available to us to keep our Town safe and are committed to keeping a low crime rate.

MONTHLY REPORT FOR (JAN 2017)

01/04 – Criminal Mischief at the 1700 block of Atlantic St. Incident happened 2 weeks earlier. Victim just returned home.

01/29 – Burglary to Vehicle. Vehicle unlocked, iPhone stolen out of it at the 600 block of Hibiscus Trail. Phone recovered, possible charges with capias sent to SAO.

01/29 – Burglary to Vehicle. Vehicle unlocked, 35 Euros stolen out of it at the 700 block of Hibiscus Trail. Money recovered, possible charges with capias sent to SAO.

01/29 – Burglary to Vehicle. Vehicle unlocked, Keys taken out of it at the 200 block of Fifth Avenue. Unknown suspects at this time.

01/30 – Burglary to Vehicle. Vehicle unlocked, keys taken out of it at the 400 block of Driftwood Ave.

MONTHLY REPORT FOR (January 2017)

01/02- Single vehicle crash at Ocean Avenue and Atlantic Street. Vehicle crashed into concrete power pole. Driver was severely injured and the vehicle was totaled. A capias was filed on the driver for driving under the influence of alcohol after an investigation was completed.

01/02- Single vehicle crash at Ocean Avenue and Oak Street. Motorcycle lost control going around a corner and the driver dropped the bike. No injuries were reported and the motorcycle had minor damage.

01/04- Criminal mischief in the 1700 block of Atlantic Street. Owner came home after being gone for the holidays and found his vehicle scratched. This incident possibly occurred when multiple other vehicles had been scratched a week prior. No suspects

01/04- Arrested a male with burglary and petit theft which had occurred a month earlier in the 600 block of Hibiscus Trail.

01/09- Arrested a male for burglary and petit theft in the 200 block of Ash Avenue. Male went into a garage and stole power tools, which was witnessed by the homeowner. After description was given to officers, the male was captured leaving the area in a vehicle.

01/27- Baker Act of a female in the 300 block of Avenue A.

01/27- Grand theft of paintings from the Melbourne Beach Library. Paintings had been left on consignment and when they owner returned to get the paintings back, multiple paintings had been taken. No suspects
