



March 2017 Monthly Report:

During the month of March our officers once again were able to keep our crime activity low. Our officers use all tools available, from Community Policing, to aggressive pro-active tactics to prevent crime in our Town. The month of March we had zero business burglary, one vehicle burglary (vehicle left unlocked) and zero residential burglary. I also come in on nights and will continue to assist with being pro-active and reduce our crime. We conducted several traffic enforcement details throughout the Town, due to resident complaints, and issued 25 traffic citations.

Animal Complaints, we had 5 calls this month. The majority of our animal complaints consist of stray, loose or injured pets, dogs in the Park or on the beach. These complaints also include calls for poisonous snakes, raccoons, etc.

Areas with a high volume calls for service are Injured or ILL persons. These types of calls are unpredictable in nature. Our Officers are First Responders and are first on scene with a medical call and are certified to perform CPR and A.E.D.

I do not see any type of trend on any major crime in the Town. I can tell you that all calls for service and crime are looked at every day and analyzed by myself or a supervisor. Depending on the type of crime we have, procedures are in place to take appropriate action to resolve the issue. I assure the residents that our Town is protected 24/7 and we will use all resources available to us to keep our Town safe and are committed to keeping a low crime rate.

MONTHLY REPORT FOR (MARCH 2017)

03/11 – Traffic Crash at the intersection of Atlantic St and Cherry Dr. Vehicle stopped waiting to make left turn, while another vehicle did not stop in time crashed into one vehicle causing it to crash into another vehicle.

03/12 – Traffic Crash at the 1200 block of Atlantic St. Vehicle heading south turned into Second Ave beach access and failed to yield to northbound traffic colliding with another vehicle causing it to crash into a mailbox.

03/12 – Unattended Death at the 1500 block of Atlantic St. Victim home alone diagnosed with stage 4 cancer.

03/18 – Burglary to a Vehicle at the 1900 block of Neptune Drive. Vehicle left unlocked and a toiletry bag was taken. Nothing of value was inside the bag.

03/20 – Verbal Domestic at Ocean Park. Boyfriend and girlfriend having a verbal argument in their vehicle that started at a bar in Vero Beach. Vero Beach PD was called, investigated and released them. Girlfriend kept kicking the interior of the vehicle damaging it and trying to get out of the vehicle while driving from Vero Beach to their residence in Indialantic. Boyfriend pulled into Ocean Park and met with officer. Both individuals under the influence and were separated for the night.

03/21 – Verbal Domestic at the 200 block of Cherry Dr. Mother and son having a verbal argument. Mother called 911 stating she was in fear of her son being out of control by “yelling and getting in her face.”

- 03/01- Crash between two vehicles at Oak Street and Ocean Avenue. Both vehicles had minor damage and no injuries were reported.
- 03/07- Crash of single motorcycle at Atlantic Street and Ocean Avenue. Motorcycle hit a cable lying in the road which caused the motorcycle to slide out. Female passenger on the back of the motorcycle had minor injuries and was transported to the hospital. There was minor damage to the motorcycle.
- 03/14- Crash between vehicle and bicyclist in the 300 block of Atlantic Street. Bicyclist was transported to the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.
- 03/14- Criminal mischief in the 200 block of Shannon Avenue. Unknown suspect(s) caused damage to a vehicle, breaking out the back window.
- 03/14- Criminal mischief in the 500 block of Banyan way. Unknown suspect(s) caused damage to a vehicle, breaking out the back window.
- 03/14- Criminal mischief in the 600 block of Hibiscus Trail. Unknown suspect(s) caused damage to a vehicle. There were dents and scratches on the vehicle and a large rock found next to it.
- 03/15- Arrested male for battery domestic violence in the 300 block of Avenue A. Husband was arrested for battering his wife during an altercation.
- 03/22- Missing, runaway juvenile in the 1200 block of Pine Street. 16 year old female ran away from home. Female came home the next afternoon without further incident.
- 03/22- Crash, hit and run, at Atlantic Street and Avenue B. A vehicle was parked on the side of Avenue B when an unknown vehicle hit it causing minor damage. There were no witnesses to the crash. A possible suspect vehicle involved was investigated, however it could not be determined to be the vehicle which caused the damage.
- 03/22- Crash between two vehicles in the 300 block of Oak Street. Both vehicles had minor damage and no injuries were reported.
- 03/30- Petit theft of a fishing pole in the 500 block of Ocean Avenue. The owner of the fishing pole and the suspect who took the fishing pole made an agreement with the pole being returned and the owner signed a decline to prosecute.
